## The role

To provide safe, effective clinical services for patients undergoing vasectomy and associated care. To follow all reasonable instructions which fall within the scope of MSIUK's Doctor's Agreement, including ad hoc requests, utilising the skill, knowledge and judgement available to the practitioner accorded by the professional status. This includes an obligation to treat all clients, irrespective of who provided previous care, and to implement the specific techniques and procedures developed by MSIUK

## Key Responsibilities

- Undertake consultation and treatment sessions according to your contract across the UK in accordance with this Job Framework
- Within conditions agreed with MSIUK (taking account of medical history, physical characteristics and risk assessment), according to the relevant process description and using the equipment and techniques made available by MSIUK, perform vasectomy for patients referred and counselled by MSIUK, providing all care necessary to ensure patient safety
- Ensure that all clinical records have been completed to a satisfactory standard. This includes the updating and maintenance of computerised/paper clinical records for patients
- Adhere to MSI techniques and procedures including but not limited to PEC guidelines, all relevant policies, procedures and clinical guidance and GMC, Royal College of Surgeons and Faculty of Sexual and Reproductive Healthcare practice requirements
- Review any client experiencing post-operative difficulties, irrespective of who performed the initial surgery and initiate appropriate remedial treatment where necessary
- Carry out any and all emergency procedures deemed appropriate at the time and using professional judgement to determine and appropriate course of action
- Provide occasional medical support to groups and individuals in the UK to ensure standardisation of clinical practice across the board and that high standards are achieved and maintained. This includes undertaking clinical audits, training and other monitoring and advisory activities
- Adhere to the MSI Choices' code of conduct.
- Work collaboratively with MSI Choice clinical team (RN,MW, HCA/VCA) , and administrative team structures ( VAS admin and results departments)
- Take part in research programmes as appropriate
- Provide ad hoc information, correspondence or reports as required
- Represent the Vasectomy service internally and externally, attending clinical and non-clinical meetings as and when required
- Proactively interact with other departments to ensure clinical links with other services as required
- Adhere to the service delivery KPIs
- Any other reasonable duties, as requested by the Clinical Director, Vasectomy Lead Surgeon or UK Head of Vasectomy.
- Take an active role in the medical referrals process, assessing suitability for treatment, and facilitating referral or transfer to another provider or NHS hospital if necessary
